MicroAid provides Community Groups with a unique capacity building service that is:

participatory,
locally empowering and
ICT enabled.

The MicroAid service uses ICT to put communities in charge of their own development. Any community group with direct or shared access to the Internet can set up their own Community Group Centre online. After a free trial period, MicroAid services membership is either purchased directly by community groups or sponsored by a donor organisation.

MicroAid membership brings the community a self help framework that promotes participation, local ownership and poverty targeting in an easy to run Community Group Centre system.

What's included in the MicroAid membership?

Provision of the MicroAid Community Group Centre System.

The MicroAid system includes member lists, supporter lists, easy to publish newsletters, design your own web site tools, self-help activity sheets, team room, community and organisation profiles, micro-project donations tracking and reporting.

Support, advisory and networking services

Email based customer support desk in Indonesia, UK based donor networking and partnership development, help with data entry and project monitoring.

System maintenance

New activities, links, monthly newsletters, backup, server hosting, security, software upgrades and bug fixing

Membership cost

This service is provided at an all inclusive cost of €90 per month (about €2 per day) for the community group. Productivity enhancing internet tools and online communications allow us to provide this service for an affordable fee.
